1.01.010 Government Structure

- c) The District is responsible to the Board of Directors [Commissioners] for the operation and administration of the District in accordance with applicable State of Texas codes, and [Name] County ordinances and orders, and ordinances, rules, regulations, policies, procedures, and guidelines adopted by the District.
- d) Directors [Commissioners] do not represent any fractional segment of the community but are, rather, a part of the body which represents and acts for the community as a whole.
