All in favor and motion carried.

Charles Froebe presented the Treasurer's Report for September 2021. Louie Brown made a motion to approve the report. Motion seconded by Owen Scott. All in favor and motion carried.

Owen Scott made a motion to adjourn. Motion seconded by Louie Brown. All in favor and motion carried.
